## **RC56**

### **5/4x6 Dry Red Cedar Clear Heart Vertical Grain**

## **RC26**

### **2x6 Dry Red Cedar Clear Heart Vertical Grain**

These are premium architectural quality softwood decks cut from clear, uniform vertical grain Red Cedar heartwood. Vertical Grain virtually eliminates the common deck problems of cupping, twisting, grain raise, and face checking. Be it hot dry sun or cool damp fog, this deck is uniquely suited to the dramatic climate changes of our region. Sold on a random length basis.

**PROS:** Stable, good rot resistance, light weight, very little face checking.

**CONS:** Expensive, lengths subject to availability, softer than Redwood.



## **DP46**

### **2x6 Port Orford Cedar C Grade**

Port Orford Cedar grows just inland along the coast of southern Oregon. This smooth, long-wearing wood is the strongest of all the cedars. Its unique properties led it to be used in a wide variety of exterior applications including stadium seating, boat frames and glue-laminated timbers. We have upgraded our stock material from D grade to a custom grade of C & Btr. This eliminated the problem of wane and planer skip.

**PROS:** Smooth, strong, even texture, local (approximately 490 miles), easy to work with, light color good for driftwood look.

**CONS:** Prone to face checking in hot sun, extractive tannin spots can be noticeable against light background before wood weathers to gray, availability limited at times.



## **KC26**

### **2x6 Dry Red Cedar Select Tight Knot**

Select Tight Knot is characterized by knots that are sound and tight. Defects are limited so they do not detract from the intended end use. The surface is smooth, and is a good choice where a natural look is desired.

**PROS:** Stable, light weight, reasonably priced, dried.

**CONS:** Allows knots, some face checking.
